

- 19 who is sick or who is exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms will be denied entry for that day.
- 20 • **FOR INDIVIDUALS APPEARING IN ANY AREAS OF THE COURT FACILITY,**
- 21 **THE USE OF MASKS IS RECOMMENDED AND ENCOURAGED, BUT NO**
- 22 **LONGER REQUIRED.**
- 23 • **ALL JUDICIAL OFFICERS OF THE SUPERIOR COURT CONTINUE TO HAVE**
- 24 **THE AUTHORITY TO ORDER ANY INDIVIDUAL TO WEAR A MASK WHILE IN**
- 25 **ANY AREA OF THE COURT FACILITY.**
